FCL.835 Basic instrument rating (BIR) (g)

(1) A BIR shall be valid for 1 year.

(2) Applicants for the revalidation of a BIR shall:

(i) within a period of 3 months immediately preceding the expiry date of the rating, pass a proficiency check in accordance with Appendix 9 to Part-FCL; or

(ii) within the validity period, complete 6 hours as PIC under IFR including:

- 3 instrument approach procedures, and

- complete a training flight of at least 1 hour with an BIR instructor.

(3) For each alternate subsequent revalidation, the holder of the BIR shall pass a proficiency check in accordance with paragraph (2)(i) in an aeroplane.

(7) For a multi-engine BIR, the proficiency check for the revalidation as well as the flying training required in paragraph (g)(2)(ii) shall be completed in a multi-engine aeroplane.
